Your Call Committee has passed another milestone on our journey to find the Pastor for Shepherd of the Valley! God has been great in leading this committee to complete the Ministry Profile Site which is now posted for everyone to see. Just access the "ELCA Synod" website and scroll to the Call Process. Click on the "openings" and key in Oregon and press the search button. We are one of a handful of ELCA churches here in Oregon looking for a Pastor. I reached out to St. Luke since they have similar priority traits and values and on the cusp of hiring their Pastor. It was nearly a 2-year search but at the end, they believe that they have found the "one". The take away with our past experience and what similar churches are finding is that the Call Process takes time, prayers and patience.

The Oregon Synod and our liaison, Bishop Assistant - Mr. Juan Carlos Puentes, holds SOV as priority one for finding the right Pastor. We hope to hear from the Oregon Synod soon as to possible candidates. Rumor is that Juan Carlos is speaking to a prospect in Texas. In preparation for the screening process, we will be conducting mock interview(s) to hone in on our interviewing skills. Each of the Call Committee members have been assigned a specific topic relating to our ministry profile priorities and important traits along with vision for SOV. They will take ownership and lead the interview discussion pertaining to their assignment, thus becoming the subject matter expert!

How can you help? Well, first and foremost would be your prayers! Secondly, if you know of any prospective ELCA Minister that should be considered, we have a Nomination form that we can complete and submit to the Oregon Synod.

Why pancakes???? The tradition of celebrating Shrove Tuesday and eating pancakes began because people wanted to use up the tempting food (eggs, butter and fat) that they were giving up for Lent. Ash Wednesday follows

the next day which starts the Lenten season. Shrove, derived from shrive, refers to the confession of sins as a preparation for Lent, a usual practice in Europe in the Middle Ages.

Little Lambs Sunday School for children ages 1-7 meets after the children's message at the 11 am worship service. Just come to the Sunday School classroom with your child (children under 3 need their parent to stay).

Lent is the period of 40 days which comes before Easter in the Christian calendar.

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, which is always held 46 days (40 fasting days and 6 Sundays) before Easter Sunday.

By observing the 40 days of **Lent**, some Christians replicate Jesus Christ's sacrifice and withdrawal into the desert for 40 days. Others will practice the 40 acts challenge using simple daily reflections and acts of generosity as a way of putting others first during preparations for Easter.
